1. Anger "can Never be Satisfied."
2. Anger is linked to Unconsecrated, Uncircumcised Flesh
  - a. The "old Man" (carnal)
  - b. The Undisciplined nature
3. Anger works Corruption -  
From "Good" to "Bad" to "Worse" to "Worst"  
- Resulting in Death and Destruction  
In your Own Life  
In the People in your life  
In Material things  
In Space around you - the "Spiritual Atmosphere"  
In your Community, your Nation, and your World
4. Anger is Folly - it belongs to the Fool.  
Four kinds of people in the book of Proverbs:  
Foolish man ~~vs~~ Foolish woman  
(vs) (vs)  
Wise man Wise woman
5. Anger belongs to Immaturity - natural and spiritual.
6. Anger disqualifies you from Leadership.
7. Anger gives Power to the Devil ... does not work the Righteousness of God.

 32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

5. MAKE NO CLOSE relationships WITH AN ANGRY PERSON. HE/SHE IS A Fool.  
 Prov. 22:24-25 -- Make no friendship with an angry man; and with a furious man thou shalt not go: Lest thou learn his ways, and get a snare to thy seuil.  
 Prov 14:16-17 -- A wise man feareth, and departeth from evil: but the fool rageth, and is confident. 17 He that is soon angry dealeth foolishly....  
 Prov 26:4 -- Answer not a fool according to his folly, lest thou also be like unto him.  
 Prov. 21:9 -- It is better to dwell in a corner of the housetop, than with a brawling woman in a wide house.  
 Prov. 21:19 -- It is better to dwell in the wilderness, than with a contentious and an angry woman.

**Rom 1:18** -- For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness;

2. HE IS slow TO ANGER.

**Ps 145:8** -- The LORD is gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy.

**Nehemiah 9:16-17**

3. HE CAN cease FROM ANGER.

**Ps 103:8-9** -- The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy. 9 He will not always chide: neither will he keep his anger for ever.

**Ps 3:5** -- For his anger endureth but a moment; in his favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning.

a. He is always in control of His anger; His anger is never in control of Him.

b. He is in control on both ends of anger –  
• before getting angry, and  
• in the process of being angry.

c. He can "repent" (change His mind) when men "repent" and people repent to Him.

**Prov 16:32** -- He that is slow to anger is the mighty; and he that ruleth his spirit shall taketh a city.

3. **STOP IT!!! Cease F**

**Ps 37:8** -- Cease from **AL** WRATH: fret not thyself

Control your anger; never let it control **INSTEAD**, replace it with forgiveness, trusting Remember, God's favorite is forgiveness, opening the door and leading to reconciliation the bridge of reconciliation.
