
What we meditate on (think about over and over again) is the best way of knowing what our future will become.






When we have opportunity to seek revenge on those who have wronged us, consider it a test of mercy.


God's favorite response way to respond to our treachery against him is to show MERCY


The more we live in awareness of His Presence, the more effortless mercy becomes.
