



A Heart Like Part 16: Trusting God's Sovereignty



We all desire to have leaders who are after God's own Heart, but that requires the people to be after the sa's






If we find ourselves ruled by leaders who are full of pride and self-will, we should ask God why they have His permission to


God's call and gifts are without repentance. We are never called to remove a leader by usurping his/ her authority.

Jesus did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, and yet he remained Lumble until God exalted Him. Unlike satan. Unlike Adam.


Whatever means we use to enter into the call of God in our lives is the means by which we will keep it.


A key to holding and demonstrating God's Leart toward mercy is to trust in His sovereignty.


