


Failing to keep God's Promise in focus opens the door for a spirit of despair.


Despair in the heart is revealed when we find ourselves taking refuge in something apart from God - even in "enemy territory."

2 So David arose and crossed over, he and the six hundred men who were with him, to Achish the son of Maoch, king of Gath.








Even when all seems lost, if the hand of God is with us, we have His favor even with our "enemies."

Ziklag ("pouring out as water/ pressing to extract what is within") is where we find out what is truly in us.














