







In every generation, God is seeking after those who will make room for Him to establish His Kingdom in the earth.


God is territorial. He is still under the notion that the earth is still His, and all the fillness thereof.







Jerusalem: Ancient City sat on 2 mountain peaks Moriah and Zion


Jerusalem:

Sanctified as a heavenly stronghold by Abraham: Melchizedek ("King of Salem")


Isaac


