John 10:1

Matthew 4:23

We turn away from all dead works: Sinful works And dead religious ones (self-righteousness)

Turn toward God and have everything that has been lost restored.

Repentance is far more than just saying, "I am sorry."

Galatians 2:20

20 "I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me.

Our salvation lies on the other side of our own cross. Jesus went first. Only by following Him in death can we receive the gift of resurrection life.

The Promise of the Gospel is not just an improvement in some areas of brokenness, it is a complete renovation of our entire life!

Romans 10:9–10
