Salvation is an ongoing
work of remaking us
into the perfect image
and likeness of God.

Salvation (sozo)

continues until we are
free from all the
remnant of our former
life of slavery to sin.

31 So Jesus was saying to those Jews who had believed Him, "*If you continue in My word, then you are truly disciples of Mine;*

John 8:31–36

32 and you will know the truth,
and the truth will make you
free."

33 They answered Him, "We are Abraham's descendants and have never yet been enslaved to anyone; how is it that You say, 'You will become free'?"

**34 Jesus answered them,
“Truly, truly, I say to you,
everyone who commmits sin is
the slave of sin.**

**35 "The slave does not remain
in the house forever; the son
does remain forever.**

36 "So if the Son makes you free,
you will be free indeed.

of the cross is to be a
daily event, not sporadic
encounters with His
power.

Being delivered from
slavery required divine
intervention.

Living as a freed son or
daughter requires our
participation.
