15 For what I am doing, *I do not understand*; for I am not practicing what I *would* like to do, but *I am doing the very thing I hate.*

one doing it, but *sin which*
dwells in me.

When we find ourselves repeating the same pattern of sin, or resisting God's leading in our everyday lives, then a demonic stronghold has been revealed.

The good news is that every
stronghold has already been
defeated at the cross.

The gooder news is that now
we get to have the fun of
demolishing whatever remains
of them.

going my own way?
