

The Tabernacle of old foreshadowed: Jesus' entire ministry as priest, sacrifice and the dwelling place of God in the earth (Emmanuel)




## **Tabernacle Overview**






























<sup>11</sup> But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation.

by <u>a new and living way</u> which He consecrated for us, <u>through</u> the veil, that is, <u>His flesh</u>,


## <sup>21</sup> and *having* a High Priest over the house of God,
